

# Mexico

Mexico is a vast country which encompasses everything from arid deserts to lush tropical rainforest, and its culture is equally diverse, influenced by the ancient Mayan and Aztec civilisations, the Spanish conquistadors and modern globalisation.

The Yucatán Peninsula is home to idyllic white-sand beaches and a turquoise sea, picturesque haciendas and impressive Mayan ruins, the most famous of which has to be Chichén Itzá. The central highlands are dotted with colonial towns, indigenous churches and relics from the country's silver mining past. The sprawling metropolis of Mexico City is a chaotic, lively and colourful city, built by the Spanish on the site of the Aztec capital and still a city of contrasts.



## Mexico City

Mexico City is truly massive, but the city is a fun, fascinating and rewarding place to visit. Founded by Spanish conquistadors, the city was literally built on top of the conquered Aztec capital of Tenochtitlán. The enormous Constitution Square or 'El Zócalo' is the city's focal point with its giant national flag, beautiful baroque cathedral, ruined Aztec temple and impressive Diego Rivera murals in the Royal Palace. Other attractions include the colourful 'floating gardens' of Xochimilco, the massed mariachi bands of Plaza Garibaldi and the impressive pre-Aztec site of Teotihuacan, famous for its giant Sun and Moon Pyramids.

## Yucatán Peninsula

Once the centre of the powerful Mayan Empire that dominated much of Central America, the Yucatán Peninsula is famous for its fabulous beaches and impressive ruined cities and temples. The best known Mayan sites include Chichén Itzá, Uxmal and Tulum, which can all be visited from Cancun, as well as the jungle-cloaked ruins of Palenque in the misty hills of Chiapas. Other highlights are the historic and well preserved colonial cities of Mérida, Campeche and San Cristóbal de Las Casas, with San Cristóbal and the wider Chiapas state also a centre for indigenous culture and language.

## Mexico Travel Tips

- **Time:** GMT -6.
- **Flying Time from UK:** Approx. 11.5 hours.
- **Language:** The official language is Spanish. English is spoken in most of the larger hotels and tourist areas. 66 regional Indian languages are still spoken.
- **Currency:** Mexican Peso (MXN) £1 = MXN 20.29.
- **Visa Requirements:** Visa not required by UK Citizens for tourist stays of up to 180 days. A blue tourist card needs to be filled in when flying in.
- **Festivals, Events & Busy Times:** The Día de los Muertos, celebrated after All Saints Day on 02 Nov, is Mexico's most traditional festival. Christmas, New Year's, Carnival, Easter and the national holiday period Jul-Aug are very busy for domestic travel.
- **Departure Tax:** Approximately US\$40 for international flights, subject to change. This tax is often prepaid as part of an international ticket.

#### Day 1: Arrive Mexico City

On arrival in Mexico City you will be transferred to your chosen hotel for a three-night stay.

#### Day 2: Mexico City Tour

Today you will be collected from your hotel for a half day tour of Mexico City. Visit the Zócalo, the main square flanked by the large baroque Metropolitan Cathedral, the National Palace and the ruined Aztec temple. Continue to the Anthropological Museum, one of the world's best and most extraordinary museums with a rich collection of Pre-Columbian art (closed on Mon). Afternoon at leisure. **(B)**

#### Day 3: Shrine of Guadalupe & Pyramids of Teotihuacan

After breakfast, you will be met for a tour of nearby historical sites. Stop first at the Guadalupe shrine before continuing to the vast Aztec ceremonial site of Teotihuacan. Climb the Sun and Moon Pyramids for amazing views. Enjoy lunch before you return to Mexico City. **(BL)**

#### Day 4: Mexico City – Oaxaca

This morning, enjoy a private tour to the town of Cholula to see the great pyramid of Quetzalcoatl, and the large church built on its top. Continue to the colonial city of Puebla for a brief sightseeing tour before driving to Oaxaca for a two-night stay. **(B)**

Standard: *Hacienda La Noria*

Deluxe: *Hostal de La Noria (Junior Suite)*

#### Day 5: Mitla & Monte Alban

After an early breakfast you will be driven to the magnificent Mixtec/Zapotec ruins at Mitla, adjacent to the present-day town. On your return to Oaxaca visit several villages known for their handicrafts. This afternoon, your guide will meet you for a tour of Monte Alban, capital of the Zapotec civilisation, with its notable observatory,

temples and ball courts. **(B)**

#### Day 6: Oaxaca – San Cristóbal de las Casas

Transfer to the airport for a flight (not included) to Tuxtla. Continue to Chiapa de Corzo for a boat trip through the majestic Sumidero Canyon where 800m walls tower spectacularly above the narrow river, stopping only to see one of the huge crocodiles if you are lucky. Transfer to San Cristóbal de las Casas in the highlands of the Chiapas region, and your overnight hotel. **(B)**

Standard: *Diego de Mazariegos*

Deluxe: *Casa Mexicana*

#### Day 7: San Cristóbal de las Casas

Today, enjoy a sightseeing tour of this picturesque colonial city to discover a world of cobbled streets, fine plazas and Indian craft markets, spiced up with bohemian restaurants and lively bars. Visit the Indian communities of San Juan Chamula and Zinacantan in the surrounding highlands. **(B)**

#### Day 8: San Cristóbal de las Casas – Palenque

This morning, leave for Agua Azul waterfalls, a place of surreal beauty where translucent blue water cascades down over travertine flowstone that has built up here over thousands of years. Continue to your hotel in Palenque. **(B)**

Standard: *Misión Palenque*

Deluxe: *Chan-Kah Palenque*

#### Day 9: Palenque – Villahermosa

Explore the jungle-choked ruins of Palenque, one of Mexico's most beautiful and impressive Mayan sites.



Highlights include the central palace and its detailed stone carvings. After lunch in a local country restaurant, continue to Villahermosa for an overnight stay. **(BL)**

Standard: *Hotel Cencalli*

Deluxe: *Camino Real Villahermosa*

#### Day 10: Villahermosa – Mérida

Tour Villahermosa this morning, starting with a visit to the giant Olmec heads in La Venta Park and also visit La Venta museum. This afternoon, take a short flight (not included) to Mérida, and transfer to your chosen hotel. **(B)**

Standard: *Hotel Los Aluxes*

Deluxe: *Intercontinental Presidente Villa Mercedes*

#### Day 11: Uxmal & Kabah Sightseeing

Today enjoy a full-day Mayan ruins tour. At Uxmal, see the elaborately decorated Pyramid of the Sorcerer and the House of the Governor. After lunch in a local restaurant, visit Kabah's fascinating palace and its impressive carvings before returning to Mérida. **(BL)**

#### Day 12: Chichén Itzá Sightseeing

Enjoy a full-day tour of Chichén Itzá, dominated by the giant El Castillo pyramid and featuring a ball court with reliefs of human sacrifice. Lunch will be included in a local restaurant before your return to Mérida. **(BL)**

#### Day 13: Depart Mérida

Transfer to the airport for your onward flight, or extend your stay and spend a few nights relaxing on the beach (not included, see page 83 for hotels).

Proceed to San Juan Teotihuacan to inspect the awe-inspiring pyramids of the Sun and the Moon, the majestic 4km Road of the Dead flanked by temples, palaces and platforms, and the impressive Temple of Quetzalcóatl. Free afternoon. This evening why not enjoy dinner in one of the fashionable restaurants in the neighbourhoods of Zona Rosa or Polanco. **(B)**

### Day 4: Depart Mexico City

Transfer to the airport for your onward flight. Alternatively continue with our Taxco & Acapulco tour, followed by a relaxing beach stay at the Pacific Coast (see below). **(B)**

### Day 1: Cancún – Mérida

This morning, drive to Chichén Itzá for a tour of the impressive Mayan ruins, dominated by the remarkable El Castillo pyramid and featuring a fascinating ball court. After lunch in a local restaurant (not included) continue your journey to the colonial city of Mérida and your overnight hotel. You will have the opportunity to enjoy an optional evening of folk music and dance.

### Day 2: Mérida – Campeche

After a short morning tour of Campeche you will drive south and see the ruins of the 'Chen Route', including Xpujil and Calakmul, the largest of the Mayan cities. Continue on to Chicanná, in the heart of the Calakmul Ecological Reserve for an overnight stay. (B)

### Day 4: Chicanná – Bacalar

During a morning tour to the ruins of Chicanná, discover carvings of mythological beasts and the home of the rulers of Becán. Becán shows evidence of one of the earliest defence systems in Mesoamerica and a selection of towers, temples and shrines. In the afternoon, transfer to your hotel on the shores of the beautiful freshwater Bacalar lagoon. (B)

Overnight: *Rancho Encantado*

### Day 5: Bacalar – Caribbean Coast

After a morning exploring the 18th century Spanish fort or



strolling along the shores of the lagoon, you will travel to Tulum for a guided tour of the Maya-Toltec ruins, which are perched on cliffs overlooking the turquoise Caribbean waters. After the tour, continue to Cancún airport or to a beach resort for a relaxing break (accommodation not included, see below for hotels). (B)
